

POST CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE INSTRUCTIONS

This certificate must be submitted with the final billing. The form is signed by the applicant and the architect or engineer who supervised the construction. If the project did not involve a consulting architect or engineers, the town, city, or county engineer should inspect the project and sign the form.

As-Built Plans

If deviations in design or site location were made from the plans previously submitted to ADECA Recreation Programs, "as-built" plans must accompany this form. As-built plans must include:

- a) site plan showing the location of the project area and facilities;
- b) elevations and floor plans of structures.

Two copies of as-built plans are to be submitted. The project sponsor must retain one set of plans which identifies the work done with federal funds at the site, at the Town/City Hall or County Courthouse.
