AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT to Agreement Numbers DTR-PS-12-002 and DTR-PS-13-002 is effective as of the 1st day of June, 2016, between the Community Service Programs of West Alabama, Inc. (herein called CSPW and in the original Agreement referred to as the Grantee) and the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (herein called ADECA).


The parties hereto do mutually agree to amend Agreement Numbers DTR-PS-12-002 dated August 8, 2012, and DTR-PS-13-002 dated June 12, 2015, including all subsequent Amendments through Amendment No. 4 dated February 15, 2016, for the purpose of transferring management responsibility for approximately 40 CSPW single family homeowner assistance cases in Allocation 2 to the Alabama Rural Coalition for the Homeless (herein called ARCH). The specific cases noted above will be jointly agreed upon in a separate agreement between CSPW and ARCH in acknowledgement with ADECA, and such agreement shall also incorporate corresponding terms, responsibilities, and financial arrangement between the two agencies. Upon the execution of said agreement between CSPW and ARCH, the management responsibility for these cases which are recognizably at different stages will fall to ARCH, and ARCH will work directly with ADECA on these cases. CSPW will remain responsible for all governing requirements applicable to the disaster single family homeowner assistance programs for the noted cases and maintain the financial and overall responsibility for these cases, including but not limited to approving work orders and invoices, requesting and disbursing funds, maintaining records, responding to inquiries, submitting reports, resolving complaints, closing projects, and providing access to files and records to auditors and state and federal officials.


In addition, for all Allocation 2 CSPW cases which have received an approved "Authorized to Proceed" from ADECA but have no payment draws or obligations, the approved "Authorized to Proceed" will be terminated and full responsibility of these cases will be transferred to ARCH under existing Agreement Numbers DTR-PS-12-003 and DTR-PS-13-003 and all their amendments. Further, all other cases currently under review at ADECA that have not received an approved "Authorized to Proceed" will be transferred to ARCH and become the full responsibility of ARCH under existing Agreement Numbers DTR-PS-12-003 and DTR-PS-13-003 and all their amendments. For all cases transferred to ARCH, CSPW will provide ARCH with complete case files comprised of original documents.

All other provisions of the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
