GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2004-15, Change 7

SUBJECT: Program Year 2005 WIA Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Allocations

1. **Purpose.** This transmits notice of FY2006 Congressional Rescissions for the WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker programs.
2. **Discussion.** Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 25-05 Attachments III-A and IV-A, copies of are Attachments 6 and 7 to this Directive Change, provides notice of the partial rescission of FY2006 WIA Adult and WIA Dislocated Worker funds earlier allotted to the State. The Department of Defense, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006, P.L. 109-148, required a government-wide reduction of 1.0 percent to all FY2006 discretionary programs, including FY2006 advance funds for the adult and dislocated worker programs provided in the FY2005 appropriation.

Note that, per USDOL/ETA staff, the 1% rescission is applied against only the originally allotted FY2006 Adult and Dislocated Worker funds. The subsequent re-allotment of \$3,340 in FY2006 Dislocated Worker funds, notice of which is provided under Changes 5 and 6 to this Directive, is not affected by this rescission action.

WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker allocations have been adjusted to reflect this rescission of FY 2006 funds. The revised FY2006 Adult and Dislocated Worker State and local area program funding levels resulting from this rescission are reflected in Attachment 1 to this Directive Change.

3. **Action.**
 - a. Local areas must submit the appropriate modifications to their respective PY2005 WIA Grant Agreement packages to the Office of Workforce Development prior to June 9, 2006.
 - b. Replace the old Attachment 1 with the new Attachment 1.
Replace the old Attachment 3 with the new Attachment 3.
Add the new Attachment 6 and Attachment 7 following Attachment 5.
