

!! IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING INCOME SURVEYS !!

Per the 2017 Application Workshop regarding Income Surveys:

- ◆ The only acceptable income limits for surveys for 2017 Applications, is the **2017 Adjusted Home Income Limits** (found in Tab 4 of the 2017 CDBG Application Manual) - DO NOT use the standard 2017 HUD Income Limits
- ◆ Previously, CDBG allowed surveys up to three years to be used in resubmitting applications. However, if the comparison to the current HUD Income Limits varies too greatly, then the 2017 HUD Adjusted Home Income Limits MUST be used. Contact Shabbir Olia if with any questions or exceptions.
- ◆ For the purposes of the Income Surveys sample forms found on the CDBG Web site, please **delete** the **60% Limits** income line entirely. The **30% Limits** will become the **Very Low Income**. The **Very Low Income** then becomes the **Low Income** and the **Low Income** will become the **Moderate Income** for the purpose of the 2017 Applications.
