#### **State of Alabama's Program Year 2017 Revised One-Year Annual Action Plans**

#### **for CDBG, HOME, ESG, HOPWA, and HTF Programs**

#### **And Supplemental Increase in ESG Program Funds**

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has notified the State of Alabama that the Emergency Solutions Grants Program (ESG) received a supplemental increase of \$161,405 in PY2017 federal funds, bringing the ESG Program's total grant award to \$2,754,579. The State's PY2017 ESG Program Plan has been updated to reflect this amount. Also, the State's PY2017 One Year Annual Action Plans for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), the ESG Program, the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program (HOPWA), the Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and the Housing Trust Fund Program (HTF) have been revised so as to contain language addressing the allowance for supplemental allocations awarded by HUD, the up or down distribution of grant funds, and the updating of Annual Plans as a result of such allocations. A 14-day public comment period is required for the revised PY2017 One-Year Annual Action Plans for these programs, and particularly for the revised ESG Plan due to the increased award amount. The purpose of the public comment period is to provide information and to receive input from interested parties on these Plans' revisions. The revised PY2017 One-Year Annual Action Plans, including the updated ESG Plan, can be viewed online at [www.adeca.alabama.gov](http://www.adeca.alabama.gov) or at the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) office at 401 Adams Avenue, Room 500, Montgomery, Alabama 36104, beginning on Saturday, July 15, 2017. Interested parties may submit written comments to the State during the 14-day public comment period, and such written comments should be received in the ADECA office no later than Friday, July 28, 2017.
