RE: Hurricanes Sally and Zeta Community Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program Orientation Workshop

The Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) invites city, county, local government elected officials, and staff to participate in an Orientation Workshop on February 16, 2023, held in the ACC Auditorium located on the 7th floor of the Alabama Center for Commerce, 401 Adams Avenue Montgomery, Alabama 36104. The Workshop will be broken into two sessions, and we ask that you only attend the relevant session.

Session 1 - Direct Allocations, 9:00am -11:00am

The second session will begin at 1:00 pm and will be for Escambia, Clarke, Dallas, Marengo, Perry Washington, and Wilcox Counties. This session will contain information concerning the LRPP and competition programs for counties not receiving a direct allocation.

ADECA is hosting these sessions to provide additional information regarding the \$501 CDBG-DR allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which was awarded to Alabama to assist in the state's long-term recovery from these two 2020 hurricanes.

Please join us in Montgomery on February 16, 2023, as we provide an overview of the disaster recovery programs. Your presence will provide an opportunity to learn more, ask questions, and provide an opportunity for everyone who attends to coordinate with those who will be involved in and are tasked with helping Alabama and its residents recover from the devastating effects of these hurricanes.
