

Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program

Contact Information for Interested Water and Wastewater Service Providers

The Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) is administering a new program called the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The tentative start date is November 2021 for local administering agencies to begin assisting households.

This program is designed to assist low-income households whose water and/or wastewater services are provided by publicly owned vendors (managed by local or state governments) or privately/shareholder owned vendors (for-profit systems managed by investors or shareholders).

Interested water and wastewater service providers will be required to sign ADECA's vendor agreement which is currently under development.
