

**LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND
POST CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE INSTRUCTIONS**

This certificate must be submitted with the final billing. The form is signed by the project sponsor and the architect or engineer who supervised the construction. If the project did not involve a consulting architect or engineer, the town, city, or county should inspect the project and sign the form.

Final Site Map

If deviations in design or site location were made from the site maps previously submitted to ADECA's Recreation and Conservation Programs, two revised final site maps must accompany this form. The final site maps must include:

1. The signature of the chief elected official and date signed;
2. The type and location of fund-assisted facilities and/or acquired properties;
3. The type and location of other existing facilities at the site;
4. The official park name or site name; and
5. The project number.

Two copies of the final site maps should be submitted. The project sponsor must retain a final site map identifying the work done with federal funds at the site, the Town/City Hall, or the County Courthouse along with all other project documentation.
