Welcome to the Alabama Surplus Property Store



Overview

ADECA's Surplus Property Division procures surplus state and federal property for its qualifying donees at a fraction of the original acquisition cost. Service fees are required for donees to obtain property. This division has two warehouses located in Montgomery (state, GSA, and LESO Federal Property) and Eva (GSA Federal Property). Both locations are open to donees Monday through Friday (excluding state holidays) from 8am to 4pm.

Eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis according to state and federal regulations. Interested public agencies and nonprofit organizations must complete the Alabama Surplus Property Program Eligibility Application.

The Alabama Surplus Property Program has compliance responsibilities for property donated to its donees pursuant to state and federal regulations. All property acquired by a donee, regardless of acquisition cost, must be placed in use within a period of 1 year from receipt and continue to be used for a year or longer depending on criteria. Recoup, our inventory management system, will automatically generate e-mail notifications and utilization forms to the Authorized Representative's electronic address on file with the Alabama Surplus Property Program.

Recoup Promote

The Promote site is an online storefront to advertise and transfer state surplus property to donees by allowing them to hold items they view online and generate invoices at pickup.

User guides and additional training resources will be available in Promote. Donees that aren't currently using Recoup will be able to setup a user login. Active Donees will be able to access Promote through the main Recoup system via a link.

Recoup Donee Portal

The Donee Portal allows donees to update application information, complete application renewals, update donee account information, and add or modify contacts under the account. The Donee Portal also allows donees to submit property requests, utilization & compliance, and continuous use forms online. Donees will receive electronic copies of LOARs, invoices, and all other program documentation. Donees will be notified via email and within the Donee Portal when an action is required under their Donee Account to minimize delays in requesting and allocating property.

The Recoup Donee Portal promises to simplify and streamline day-to-day processes, and donees will feel a true sense of control when managing their accounts.
